Faculty in PH will teach PH250 (online 2 cr in fall in years 1 and 2 and in both fall and spring in subsequent years). This course is already a part of the curriculum and thus, already covered in faculty loads. Faculty in biology will teach the remaining three classes. Biol 321 will be taught in the fall of the first two years and in both fall and spring in subsequent semesters. Biol 321 is a lab course that will have to be covered as a regular course on someone's AWP. Biol 322 will be taught for the first time in spring of year 1 Biol 323 will be taught for the first time in fall of year 2. These courses are internship courses and can be covered in the department with current faculty. None of the faculty are new and no new lines are required. None of the classes use teaching assistants. All of the courses currently exist; creation of the three biology courses was covered by the first year of the grant.
