UofL including UofL Health have a combined budget of more than \$4B; the academic side has a budget of \$1.5B. Segal claimed that schools with budgets that were less than half of UofL's, with expenses as low as \$600M, were a "match" to UofL.

UofL was said to have 2,035 faculty. Schools that Segal regarded as matching had as many as 4,000 and as few as 1,500 faculty. Other schools that did not meet the filter also are in the sample.

Segal 57 school sample: A large and diverse sample is better for estimating public opinion than establishing benchmarks

SEGAL SAMPLE IS NOT A CLOSE MATCH TO UOFL

Average match of just 4.6 filters out of 7 or 65.66%, which earns a D grade

- <u>5 schools met 7 filters</u> (U. Tennessee-Knoxville, Connecticut, Missouri-Columbia, Virginia Commonwealth, *West Virginia),
- 14 met 6 filters (*Stony Brook, *Temple, *Univ. of Illinois-Chicago, *Univ of New Mexico) (assuming the 37 school sample)
- <u>10 met 5 filters</u> (*Wayne State University).
- 13 met just 4 filters (Univ. of Florida, Augusta (GA) Univ.),
- <u>11 met only 3 filters</u> (Univ. of Minnesota-Twin Cities, Univ. of Idaho),
- 2 met a scant 2 filters (Univ. of Michigan-Ann Arbor, Western Michigan Univ.) and
- 1 met an astonishing 0 filters (Idaho State).

Because 53 of 54 schools met the Retention Rate filter, making it an ineffective criterion, the degree of match is less than it seems.

- 46 schools have lower expenses than UofL (\$3.0B).
- 43 schools have smaller faculties than UofL (2,031).
- 45 schools have smaller staffs than UofL (6,000).
- 35 schools have smaller endowments than UofL (\$719,816,000).
- <u>29 schools have smaller enrollments</u> than UofL (22,684).

Divergent schools can be used to provide information on rare units but do not belong in the primary benchmarking sample.

THE SEGAL SAMPLE SALARY MEAN IS \$4,534 LOWER THAN THE PRESIDENTIAL SAMPLE SALARY MEAN, \$7,219 LOWER THAN THE CPE BENCHMARKS MEAN AND \$18,798 LOWER THAN THE ACC MEAN.
