The Executive Committee (XC) heard reports from Standing Committees, as well as from a representative of the Student Government and Staff Senate. Susan Peacock reported from Part-

Time Faculty Committee that timing between the reporting of new hires from the Unit to HR is slow, and therefore it is difficult to inform all new Part Time Faculty about Orientation.

The Executive Committee unanimously voted to endorse a request for the Faculty Senate Chair to serve as a voting ex-officio member on the Foundation Board. The following statement has been presented to Diane Medley, the chair of the UL Board of Trustees and the Executive Director of ULF.

The Faculty Senate of the University of Louisville strongly encourages the Foundation to create, in accordance with proper operating procedure, a permanent, ex-officio voting Faculty Representative position on its Board of Directors, filled by the Chair of the Faculty Senate, in order to represent the faculty of the University of Louisville in the Foundation's stated goals and purposes.
