

## **Report of the Part-time Faculty Committee of the Faculty Senate for April 2018**

The Part Time Faculty Committee met on Wednesday, April 11, in the Delphi Center Lab in Ekstrom Library.

The committee heard the chair report. Roy reported on his participation with the Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate. The committee has been following with interest the parking changes which will be implemented in fall semester 2018. While it is unclear if the proposal we have heard has received final approval, we assume they will be. The Executive Committee has been focused on potential changes coming from the Kentucky Legislature regarding tenure and Roy reported that the Executive Committee had a meeting with the UofL BOT Tenure and Nepotism sub-committee for the purpose of assisting board members in understanding the tenure and post-tenure review processes at UofL.

The committee has heard that the clarification of federal hiring guidelines recently issued by Human Resources has some part time faculty unsettled. Roy announced that he and the leadership of the Faculty Senate would be meeting with John Elliott in Human Resources to seek clarification on this matter, specifically any impact the guidelines may have on part time faculty.

The majority of our meeting was spent with members sharing the results of their research into UofL benchmark and other ACC institutions with regard to policies and procedures pertaining to part time faculty. The committee is gathering data as part of our desire to produce a series of guidelines for deans and chairs at UofL regarding how to best deal with issues surrounding part time faculty. The next step will be to use this information to provide support and guidance for us as we begin to generate our guidelines.
