Report of the Part-time Faculty Committee
February 2023

The Part Time Faculty Committee met on Monday, February 6, from 3:30 to 4:30 pm on Microsoft Teams.

Chair's Report: Chairman Roy offered updates regarding issues which have been discussed in the Executive Committee. HB136 and its implications for UofL; priorities for the new president.

The committee welcomed Brian Buford from the Employee Success Center. Brian gave an overview of the work of the Employee Success Center. Committee members asked questions regarding the onboarding process which has been established for new employees and discussed spreading the word regarding the online module for part time faculty which can be accessed anytime. This is a departure from previous part time faculty orientations which had fallen off due to low participation, due to the orientation being held during the day which is not ideal for part time faculty who work outside of the university.

Discussion: The committee continues to monitor the implementation of Workday. We plan to work with the Office of Faculty Affairs in developing and implementing a process by which part time faculty are recognized for years of service. Such processes occur for full-time faculty and staff and we believe a similar recognition should be made for part time faculty.

The committee looks forward to the hiring of a Part Time Faculty Coordinator, who will work with the Vice Provost for Faculty Affairs and will function as an advocate for HR matters for part time faculty.
