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What is Emergency Management?

The Emergency Management Program leads the coordination of campus, local, state, federal, and other community resources to provide comprehensive emergency management operations to the University of Louisville community. Emergency Management oversees the prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery activities that protect life, property, and the environment from all man-made and natural threats and disasters that impact the campus community and its neighbors.

The Department of Emergency Management consists of a Full Time Emergency Coordinator, currently three Capstone students and myself all under the Department of Public Safety.

We work with University Police Dept, Physical Security and Fire Marshal, Physical Plant, Environment Health and Safety, local agencies, LMPD, FBI and Homeland Security to plan, train and organize responses. We work and train with stakeholders such as public service agencies, all utility companies, and responders.
