

Export Control Policy

April 22, 2025

At present, UofL does not have a formal policy statement in this area. To this point, UofL has operated under an Export Control Compliance Manual the combines policy like statements but does not carry the full standing of an administrative policy.

Federal sponsors are increasing scrutiny and regulation of controlled research and activities. Likewise, UofL is engaged in efforts to increase this area of the research portfolio. It is important that UofL formalize its commitment to complying with the export control regulations so that it is best positioned to eligible for funding opportunities incorporating heightened security requirements.

This draft was developed in conjunction with University Counsel. In addition to regulatory resources, this draft was modeled and referenced content from Brown University, Indiana University, Purdue, Colorado State, Texas A&M, and Harvard.
