What and Why



- The central goals of One IT plan
 - Service: improve responsiveness and service delivery
 - Security: reduce risk of data loss
 - Efficiency: consolidate administrative systems
 - Equity: ensure that faculty and staff have appropriate IT
- Accelerate progress towards these goals
 - Rapid change in both regulatory and risk factors
 - Financial uncertainty

Timeline



- Now July
 - Intensive assessment of all university IT resources
 - Restructuring central IT
 - Individual unit engagement to identify unique and common IT needs
- July August
 - Staff reporting line transition period
 - High-level plan developed and shared
- August December
 - Detailed plan for per-unit service delivery
 - New budget model developed

Keys to Success



- Avoiding: reduced support, inadequate planning, staff losses
- Embracing: savings for the core mission, principles of equity and effectiveness
- Effective solid / dotted line reporting
- IT Structure / People to lead:
 - Professional school support
 - Traditional academic support
 - Staff / Administrative support
 - All within a strong team / cross-communicative / partnership model with technical areas
- Strong, engaged IT governance model
- Systems and processes to manage services
