REPORT: Interim University Provost - Bradley

Dr. Bradley updated the Senate on the six-year graduation rate progress and predictions., enrollment and retention, accreditation, administrative searches, artificial intelligence and its committee, and the Faculty Compensation Study.

<u>UPDATE: Research Strategic Plan & General Report - Gardner</u>

Dr. Gardner reported on initiatives to foster research, scholarship, and creative activity. He also reported on the strategic plan and updates to the Cayuse research administration system. His office recently rolled out a digital science product called Dimensions, which cross-references various works from clinical trials to patents to grants and publications. A search on a subject returns a list of all entries in the program on that subject.

Mr. Depp reported that he is looking into holding a book sale, as had been done in the past.

REPORT: Faculty Senate Chair - Mueller

Chair Mueller reported on the following topics.

B.S. in Exercise Physiology – This program was proposed and approved in November. Its budget included a compensation comparison and salary adjustment, which raised concerns. Both were administratively removed from the proposal that will go to the Board of Trustees.

Election Reporting - The Executive and REDBOOK committees are working with the Committee on Committees & Credentials (CCC) on an amendment to the Senate Bylaws to address reporting of election tallies and electronic voting. The vote tallies of the last election are listed in the CCC report.

Certificate Program Reactivated – The Graduate Certificate in Logistics and Distribution has been proposed for reactivation by the Provost's Office. The suspended program will be renamed, and the original eighteen credit hours will be reduced to nine. The Faculty Senate's role in reactivation of a suspended program after substantial revision is an ongoing topic of discussion.

Budget Process – A way to regularize Faculty Senate input in the budget process is still under development.
