REGULAR MEETING - CALL TO ORDER - Mueller

ACTION ITEM: Approval of the April Minutes – Mueller

The April meeting minutes were approved and are online and linked above.

REMARKS: University President - Schatzel

President Schatzel updated the Faculty Senate on the state legislative session that ended in April and the impact of its biennial budget on UofL. Each state institution received pro-rated funds to offset inflation cost increases, and UofL received \$5.1M for each year in the biennium. UofL received restricted funds for specific initiatives that included a cybersecurity program, pediatric cancer research, an immigration law clinic, the Rural Dental Outreach Program, and several others. This budget provided funds for the Health Sciences Simulation Center & Collaboration Hub, UofL Health's Center for Rural Cancer Education and Research, and a second round of asset preservation. Authorization was also granted for the issuance of agency bonds of up to \$302.2M for thirteen capital projects. This was the largest appropriation to the university in its history. INTRODUCTION: Vice Provost for Information Technology Services & CIO - Kaugars

The new Vice Provost for Information Technology Services and Chief Information Officer, Dr. Karlis Kaugars was introduced and recounted his career leading to his appointment at UofL in April of this year. He has started a listening tour and shared his initial thoughts and plans for improvement. The report is online and linked above.

REPORT: University Provost - DePuy

Dr. DePuy updated the Senate on the FAFSA situation. The Financial Aid Office worked diligently to release over 3200 financial aid packages to our students by May 1. Another 3800 financial aid packages will be released by May 3. This problem with FAFSA data impacts new and returning students. Compared to May 1, 2023, applications are up 7%, and admissions are up 5%, but deposits and summer orientation attendance numbers are currently down. The report is online and linked above.

REPORT: Artificial Intelligence Committee Report – Boehm/Fernandez

Committee co-chairs Dr. Beth Boehm and Dr. Jose Fernandez reported on the findings of the Committee on the Use of Generative Artificial Intelligence in UofL Academics. Dr. Boehm introduced subcommittee chairs Dr. Kelvin Thompson and Prof. David King to participate in the presentation, which was designed by Mr. Alex Glynn. Dr. Boehm explained that the committee's charge was limited to identifying relevant use cases surrounding academics and undergraduate/graduate student research. Though the committee met its charge, the recommendations show more work remains. The report is online and linked above.

UPDATE: ATHENA Presentation - Nasraoui

Dr. Nasraoui updated senators on the various activities of the National Science Foundation (NSF)-funded ATHENA Project. The ATHENA Project contributes to the NSF's goals for the development of a more diverse and capable science and engineering workforce by increasing the representation and advancement of women in academic science and engineering careers. It also seeks to broaden the use of evidence-based systemic change strategies that promote equity for STEM faculty in academia based on gender, race and ethnicity.
