REPORT: Faculty Compensation Study Methodology - Mayefsky

Provost Bradley introduced Segal consultant, Dr. Moshe Mayefsky who updated the Faculty Senate on the methodology used for the pay equity portion of the Faculty Compensation Study. The goal of this portion of the study is to ensure there is no disparity based on gender, race, ethnicity, age or any other protected class. Dr. Mayefsky went over the quantifiable measures and explained how that was not enough to guarantee equity. There are other unquantifiable measures that come into

play, and he explained how the study looked deeper into variances to develop a model that encompasses 75% of the salary data and then addresses the outliers.

REPORT: University Provost - Bradley

Dr. Bradley updated the Faculty Senate on the federal student aid program disaster that has impacted students across the country. After proactively addressing the issue, the deficit in incoming first year students who made a deposit was reduced from 540 to 17. Credit for this huge achievement goes to Jenny Sawyer's team in Admissions and Jim Begany's team in Enrollment Management. The presentation is online and linked above.

UPDATE: UofL Health - Miller

Mr. Tom Miller, CEO of UofL Health presented senators with information on the growth and expansion of the healthcare system. The presentation began with an organizational chart and covered the facilities throughout the region. UofL Health has the region's only Level 1 Trauma Center, Kentucky's only dedicated Burn Center, and a nationally-accredited Stroke Center. Mr. Miller gave the history of each facility under UofL Health, a financial overview of the system, and strategic plans for the future. The presentation is online and linked above.
