## FACULTY SENATE MEETING MINUTES JULY 3, 2024

Remarks: University President - Schatzel

Dr. Schatzel touched on several topics.

**Board of Trustees** - The Board of Trustees met last week and approved the budget, which is the largest in the university's history. UofL also received its largest-ever state appropriation this year.

**Executive Vice President for Health Affairs** – After a national search, Dr. Jeff Bumpous was recently hired to permanently fill this position after serving in an interim role.

**Vice Provost-Human Resources** – After a national search, it was announced that Mr. Darrell Clark will fill the position on August 1, 2024.

#### Introduction: Dean of the School of Public Health - Cardarelli

Dr. Kathryn Cardarelli described her journey from Texas to Kentucky and her eventual arrival at UofL. Dr. Cardarelli is a health equity researcher and is passionate about research and collaboration. Strategic planning will begin this fall to create a vision that incorporates input from all stakeholders.

## **Report: University Provost - DePuy**

Senior Vice Provost Dr. Gail Depuy reported that there will be more students this fall than last year, despite the challenges surrounding FAFSA. She went over enrollment numbers, addressed administrative hirings and reported on new student fees. This report is linked above.

### **Update: UofL Athletics - Heird**

Athletic Director, Mr. Josh Heird shared his philosophy of collegiate athletics. He received his MBA from UofL while working in Athletics about 10 years ago. He went to Villanova for three years and returned here five years ago. He sees athletics as a piece of the university as a whole and not the overarching center. This prefaced the main discussion point of the athletic budget. This presentation is online and linked above.

### Discussion: Potential changes to the 2025-2026 Academic Calendar v.8 - DePuy

Dr. DePuy presented a proposed change to the spring 2026 academic calendar that would start the semester later in January and split finals between the weeks before and after Derby. The reason for the proposed change is to allow student services (advising, registrar, financial aid, bursar, etc.) more time at the beginning of the spring semester to handle transfer students. After a discussion of the pros and cons of the changes the following motion was made by Senator Jose Fernandez.

I move to maintain the traditional schedule that ends before Derby, and we recommend that resources be provided to Student Services to handle the increased number of transfer students.

The motion was seconded and overwhelmingly approved. The proposed calendar changes are linked above.
