Introduction: EVP - Finance and Administration - LeMay

Mr. Aaron LeMay was introduced and shared his background in higher education and healthcare. This presentation is linked above.

Report: Interim University Provost - Cardarelli

Interim Provost Cardarelli reported on the following topics. This presentation is linked above. **Dean Searches:** The Provost announced the hiring of Dr. Amy Henley as the new Dean of the College of Business and the progress of the Dean of Dentistry search.

Enrollment: The Provost highlighted a 23% increase in first-time college students, and an 8% increase for continuing students.

Legislative Updates: The Provost discussed the impact of recent legislative changes, including House Bill 4 and the Dear Colleague letter, and the university's efforts to comply with these directives by creating work groups and holding retreats to address compliance issues.

Faculty Compensation Study: Dr. Cardarelli and Dr. David Schultz, the AVP for Finance and Administration, presented the second phase of the faculty compensation study, focusing on addressing compression for associate and full professors and the distribution of remaining funds, with detailed explanations of the methodology and projected results.
