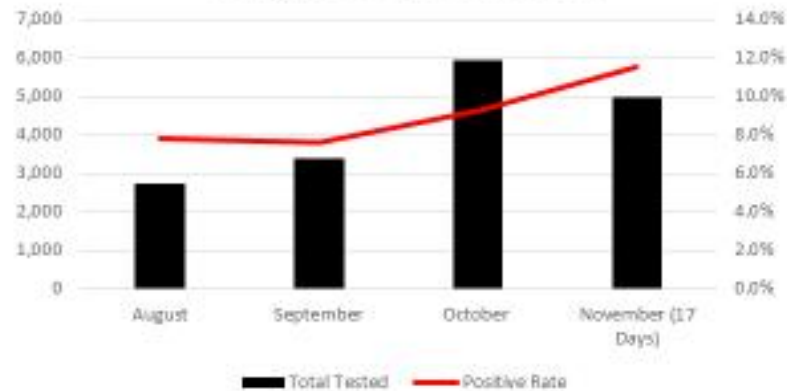

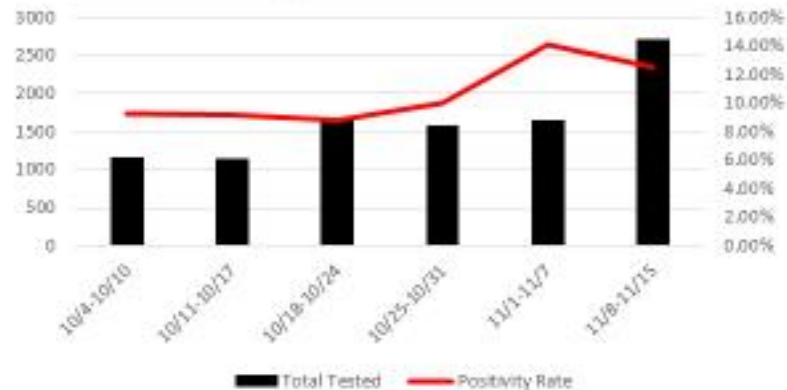

# GOALS

- Goal 1
  - Baptist Health, Norton Healthcare and UofL Health, to establish a collaborative bed operations to manage patient flow during COVID state of emergency.
- Goal 2
  - Triage patients to the appropriate location based on level of care and sub-specialty coverage **and maintain transfer and care capacity** for the entire care area served by the three hospital systems
- Goal 3
  - Act as a network for providers to share protocols and treatment plans as situation evolves



# BED OPERATIONS

1. Daily Inter-system Bed Huddle to discuss operational capacity and assist with bed management
2. Collaborative Access Center contact line for interfacility transfer and to assist in surge capacity management
3. Surge Capacity Management/Triage Calls as needed
