




Fall 2020 National Enrollment Trends – First Time Freshman





Public 4yr -1.9% UofL +0.2%




Public 4yr +3.6% UofL +10.6%



What's been done to improve New Student enrollment?

- Developed a Strategic Enrollment Management Plan with 18 Action Items
- Out-of-State Targeted Regional Recruitment
- Need based Aid
- Targeted Diversity Initiatives (awards, Latinx recruiter, community programs, diversified staff)
 - African American undergraduate enrollment up 17% since Fall 2016
 - Latinx undergraduate enrollment up 36% since Fall 2016
- Adult and Online
- Holistic Admission
 - Moved to test optional
- Connections to Companies
 - Hospital System
 - Mortenson
 - Trilogy Health
- Implemented Customer Relationship Management System (CRM)



Looking Towards the Future

- Focus Area 1: Pricing and Institutional Aid
 - additional students by adding and shifting \$5 million institutional aid dollars to need based. (8% to 20%)
- Focus Area 2: Academic Programs
 - additional fully on-line students
 - additional students through the development of new academic programs
- Focus Area 3: International Student Enrollment
 - additional students through the expansion of our recruitment efforts.
- Focus Area 4: Undergraduate Recruitment
 - additional students through the development of our regional out-of-state recruitment markets
- Focus Area 5: Graduate Recruitment
 - additional students through increased marketing efforts.
- Focus Area 6: Pathways
 - additional students through evening and weekend degree options, community colleges and military
