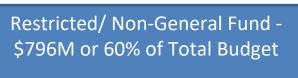

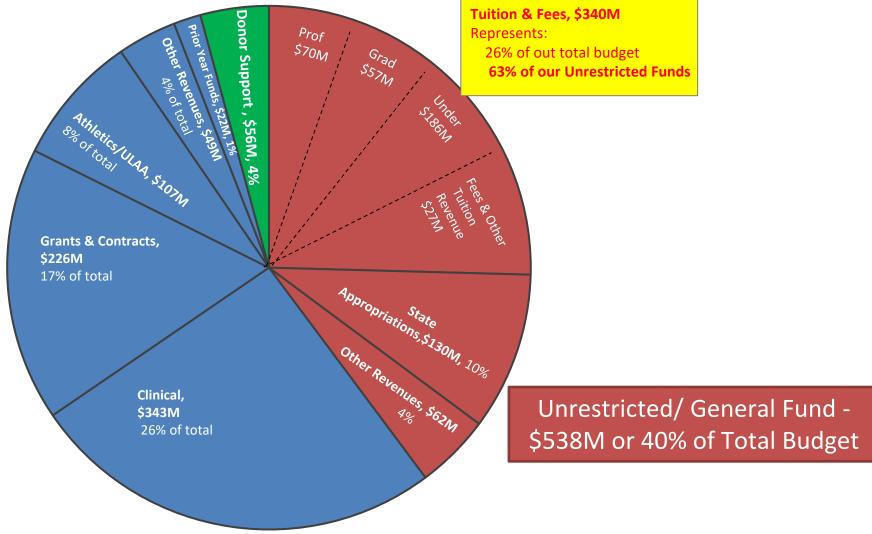
#### **Overview of FY 2022 Sources of Funds**

### **Factors Influencing Our Tuition Rates**

#### External factors

- Political (Legislative)
- Council on Postsecondary Education
- Environmental
- Affordability
- Benchmarking to competitors (currently 2<sup>nd</sup> highest in State)

#### Internal Factors

- Shared governance process
- Consideration of total cost of attendance (housing, dining, tuition, fees)
- Recommendations made to university leadership by tuition taskforce by a broad group of stakeholders

### **State Appropriations: Two Components**

- Biennial state budget includes funding for universities
- Two components: Base (\$127M) and Performance Funding (\$3M)
- State law enacted in 2017 created state performance funding pool
  - \$17 million in new money added to the system in FY 2022
  - UofL received ~\$3 million of the new funds that are at risk annually based on model
  - Revised statute returns all \$17M back to pool and will be reallocated each year based on each university's performance relative to the others

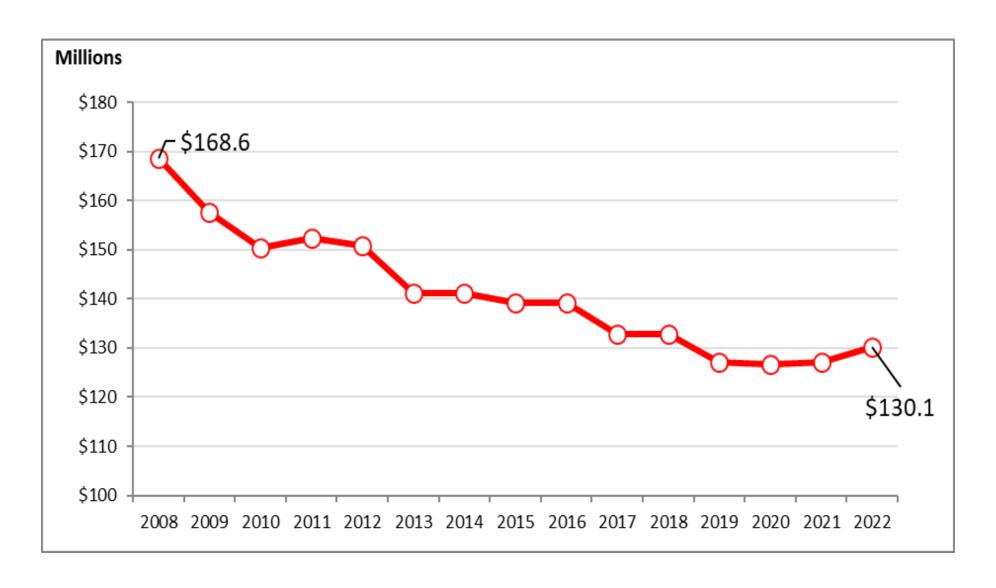

Key Point: Competing with all public universities in KY for these funds- its how we perform in comparison to the others!

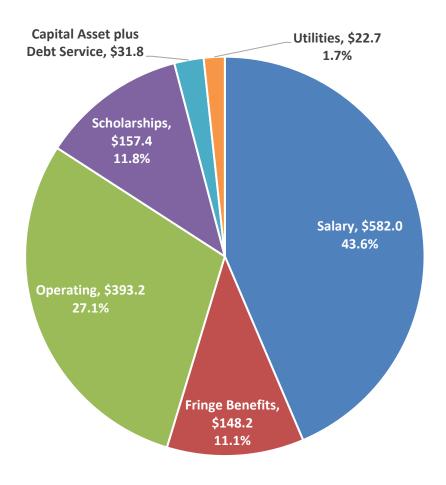

### History of State Support to UofL Since FY 2008

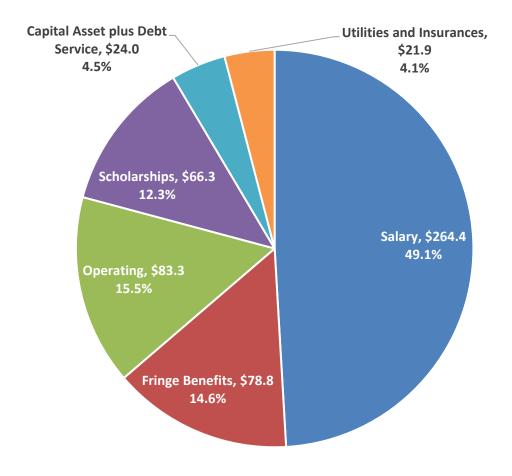


## What Are We Budgeting? Expenses by Category and Component

# The Distribution of our General Fund Budget: Every Dollar Has Defined Purpose

- There are no "unallocated" general fund dollars our needs exceed our available revenues and growth is constrained by general fund availability
- An increase in an expense budget must come from unbudgeted revenue increases or reductions of other current expense budgets
- Over 80% of our General Fund Budget is allocated to academic units and other mandatory fixed cost items (ex. utilities, student aid, insurance)

### Where Does This Leave Us?

- We are facing challenges that are game changers:
  - Employee compensation needs increased
  - Funding for health insurance cost increases
  - Facilities upkeep
  - Rising costs of getting normal things done (inflation)
  - The enrollment "cliff" coming in 2025 will impact enrollment and institutional aid

- Substantial cash already exists in the Foundation to help meet unit needs its ready for immediate use !!
- We must also re-think everything we do how can we do it less expensively (without sacrificing quality) and what should we stop doing to redirect dollars toward other things (compensation)

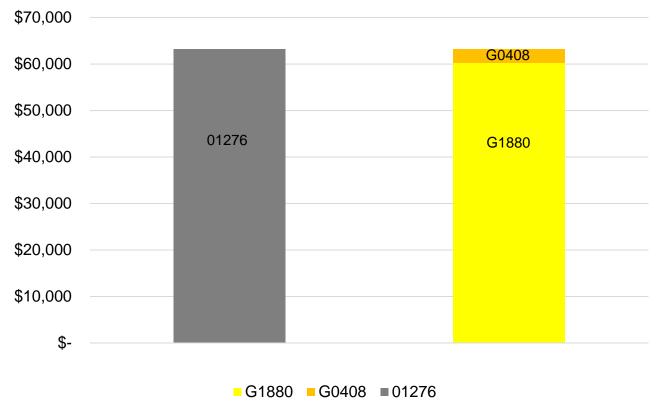

# **Chemistry Department**

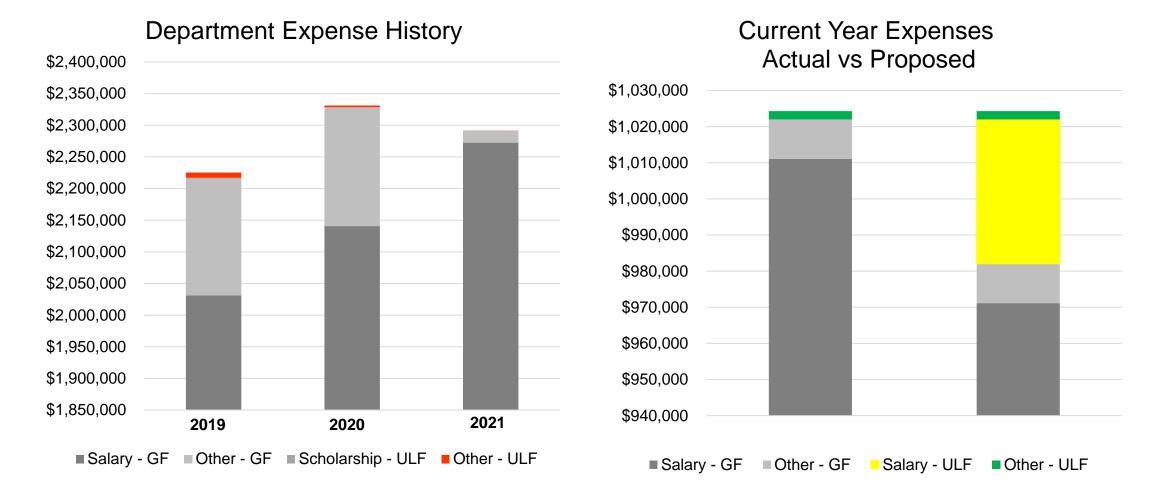
- \$63,235.66 of salary charged to 01276, fund 1000A FYTD22

# Accounting Department

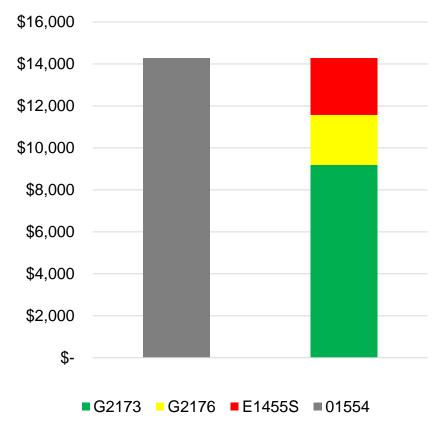
- Foundation funds: \$39k available in total/ \$2k spent FYTD
- Department almost entirely funded from General Funds over the past five years
- \$7k added to unrestricted Foundation funds in last 4 months recieved



# Accounting Department

- \$370k total accounting scholarships have been charged to 3010xxxxxxx dept. ID. Only \$108k funded from Foundation programs.
- There is approx. \$40k in scholarships remaining that can be funded from the Foundation:
  - Charge G2173 \$9,200.01 to fund 01554 Olivia (student #1504444) scholarship
  - Charge G2176 \$2,385.00 to fund 01554 Christina (student #1556485) scholarship
  - Charge E1455S \$2,703.13 to fund 01554 Hunter (student #1560273) scholarship
  - Entries will reduce general fund expenses by \$14k
