ACTION ITEM: Approval of the June Minutes - Mueller

REMARKS: University President - Schatzel

Dr. Schatzel touched on several topics.

Board of Trustees - The Board of Trustees met last week and approved the budget, which is the largest in the university's history. UofL also received its largest state appropriation this year.

Executive Vice President for Heath Affairs - Dr. Jeff Bumpous was recently hired to permanently fill this position after a national search.

The reason for the change is to allow student services (advising, registrar, financial aid, bursar, etc.) more time at the beginning of the semester to handle transfer students starting in the spring. A discussion took place of the pros and cons of changing the calendar. The following motion was made by Senator Jose Fernandez.

Move to maintain the traditional schedule that ends before Derby and we recommend that resources be provided to Student Services to handle the increased number of transfer students.
