REPORT: Covid Update & Chair Report - John Smith

Chair Smith reported on the following topics.

COVID - There are still about 465 people that we don't know the current status of. About 150 of those tell us they are vaccinated, but we can't confirm that at this point. So, the contact tracers are continuing to work on that with the remaining people. There have been between 40 and 50 exemptions filed from faculty and staff. As of December 8, the vaccination rate on the COVID dashboard had staff were at 93.3%, faculty were at 92.8% and students were at 91.2%.
