Faculty Senate Meeting Staff Senate Update [May 3, 2023]

Staff Senate met on April 11, 2023

- a. Chief Steve Green (ULPD): ULPD Chief Steve Green provided a summary of the events from Monday morning at the Old National Bank as well as the shooting that occurred at JCTC. Chief Green said that offices can contact Major Oscar Chavez of the ULPD if they are interested in having individualized active shooting training for their area.
- b. Brad Andersen and Amber Peter (ITS): Brad Andersen provided an update on the new website project. UofL has engaged the services of Mighty Citizen which is an implementation consulting company. Drupal, the new website platform, has been purchased through a company called Aqua. UofL's web footprint has over 400,000 pages across the louisville.edu domain. The website infrastructure is being build from scratch. Old content is not being migrated to the new site. Beginning in early June, there will be a change to the look and feel of UofL's homepage. UofL is also investigating the possibility of an intranet to host content internal to UofL. This will reduce the content available to the public on the louisville.edu site. Amber Peter explained the need for an intranet as opposed to simply using SharePoint. SharePoint has limitations when sharing content across multiple groups. It lacks the interconnectivity of an intranet.
- c. Camden Harris (SGA): Camden Harris provided an update on the SGA response to the animal cruelty incident. Currently, animal cruelty is not explicitly stated in the Student Code of Conduct. However, SGA has drafted a resolution to have the Student Code of Conduct updated to include language addressing animal cruelty. Staff senate supports this resolution.
