As of today, January 6th, 2025, All U.S. travelers will be <u>required</u> to have a *REAL ID* compliant license or another acceptable form of identification to board domestic flights and access certain federal facilities. The deadline for full enforcement of the <u>REAL ID is May 7, 2025</u>.

REAL ID: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

How Do I Know If I Have a REAL ID?

- Check your driver's license or state ID for a star in the upper right-hand corner. This star indicates that your ID is *REAL ID* compliant.
- If your ID does not have a star, it is not *REAL ID* compliant, and you will need to obtain a new one to meet the upcoming requirements.



Steps to Obtain a REAL ID:

- 1. Please click <u>HERE</u>, then scroll down to locate and click on your state to identify exactly what documentation is required to obtain a *REAL ID* for your state. This is typically found by doing a search on state website for "Real ID".
 - At a minimum, you must provide documentation showing:
 - 1) Full Legal Name
 - 2) Date of Birth
 - 3) Social Security Number
 - 4) Two Proofs of Address of Principal Residence
 - 5) Lawful Status
- 2. States may impose additional requirements, please check with your specific state's driver's licensing agency website, before visiting them in person, for additional guidance and assistance.
