Please do not submit this page with your proof of legal relationship form. It is a resource for you to keep.

On your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), you reported that both parents are deceased, you were in foster care, a dependent or ward of the court, an emancipated minor, or in a legal guardianship. To confirm this information, our office is requesting that you print, complete, and return the attached "Proof of Legal Relationship" form with a handwritten signature and supporting documentation. Forms submitted without the requested documentation and signatures are incomplete and cannot be processed.

After reviewing your form and documentation, our office may request additional information or documentation, request that you make corrections to your FAFSA, or make corrections to your FAFSA¹. Make sure to monitor your UofL e-mail account and Tasks list for additional information about the status of your account. Please note there may be a hold placed on your account until all information is verified. Processing is completed when you no longer see "Proof of Legal Relationship" in your Ulink Task Tile.

The checklist status in your ULink Task Tile will change throughout the process. Descriptions of each status
