



Tier One: assessment of **student learning** within the course



Are students demonstrating the intended learning outcomes?

Student will demonstrate the QEP learning outcomes within the seminar course through assignments and activities.

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

1 Students will demonstrate **informed decision-making** marked by identifiable measures of reflective learning, independent inquiry, and critical thinking.

2 Students will report an increase in their **sense of academic and social belonging or fit** as measured by the pre- and post-FYF assessment scale.

3 Students will report an increase in their **sense of decidedness** as measured by the pre- and post-PAI assessment scale.

4 Students will report an increase in their **sense of self regulated behavior** as measured by the pre- and post-FYF assessment scale.

Project-level Student Learning Outcomes (Preliminary Findings)

Informed Decision Making

(Outcome 1) [review in process]

- Reflective Learning (APP and Reflection Journals)
- Independent Inquiry (I-Search, APP, Reflection Journals)
- Critical Thinking (I-Search Paper and Presentation)

Sense of Decidedness (Outcome 3)

- Students are reporting significant increases in both major and career decidedness.
- Significantly higher increase in major decidedness.

Sense of Belonging (Outcome 2)

- Overall, reported incremental increases in appropriate items.
- Students' reporting high levels of belonging in pre-test.

Sense of Self-Regulated Learning (Outcome 4)

- Overall, reported incremental increases in appropriate items.
- Students reporting high levels of awareness in pre-test.
