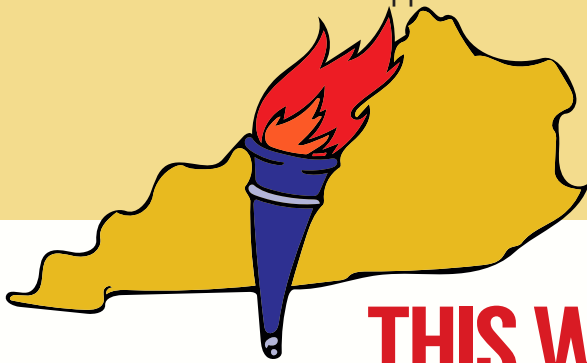

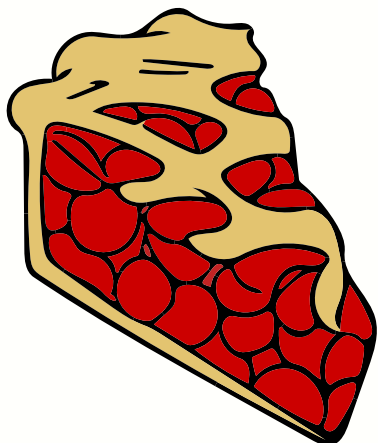
LEAP DAY TRIVIA NIGHT NEXT WEEK!

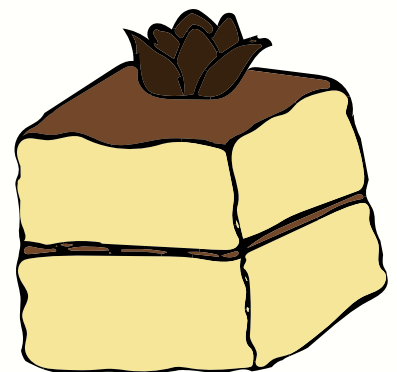


PIE vs CAKE - VOTE NOW! ETSCORN FRONT DESK
