Submissions are free and open to the public. We ask that all submissions are previously unpublished final drafts created solely by the author. Concurrent submissions are permitted, but please let us know as soon as possible if your piece has been accepted by another publication.

Subject Line of Email: Genre, Your Last Name

(ex: Poetry, Smith)

Name of Attached Document: Title of Work

Please include the following information in the body of the email:

- -Your full name as you would like it to appear if published
- 2-3 sentence author bio
- Art submission: medium and dimensions of the piece

In order to ensure that your submissions are judged fairly, all submissions are reviewed anonymously. Your name should not appear on the attached document, only the subject line and body of the email.

If you are submitting work in more than one category, please send separate emails per genre (i.e. all poetry submissions attached to one email, and all visual art .jpegs attached to another).

Genre Specific Guidelines

Prose:

Attached Word Document
Limit ten pages total per submission cycle
Times New Roman, size 12 font.
1" margins, double-spaced.
Page numbers at bottom right-hand corner.

Poetry:

Attached Word Document Limit three poems per submission cycle. Times New Roman, size 12 font 1" margins, left alignment preferred

We will make every effort to preserve the spacing and format of your poetry as it is sent.

Visual Art:

Attached .JPEG or .PNG file Image quality: 300 DPI or higher

If you are submitting images of 2D or 3D art, please consider the quality and composition of the image to suit the magazine format.
