# MOVE OUT INFORMATION

## Spring Move-Out Information



Residents are required to check out of their campus assignments within 24 hours of their last final exams and no later than **10am on Friday, May 1, 2015**. Under no circumstances may residents stay beyond this closing date without completing an Extension Request Form.

If residents have a circumstance that requires them to remain past the official closing date and time for graduation should complete the [Spring Extension Request Form](#). Students who are a part of band, first term summer school, summer staff, or SOS should not fill out the form. Extension Form requests are due on **Friday, April 23rd**.

## Move-Out Checklist

Before moving out, make sure you do these things:

- ✓ Sign up with your RA to schedule your checkout 24 hours after your last final, with the final time to check-out at 10am on May 1
- ✓ If there is a conflict with your appointed time, contact your RA in a timely manner in order to reschedule
- ✓ Be on time for your checkout
- ✓ Be proactive about your packing. Have everything packed up before your last final to have a faster/easier checkout
- ✓ Please leave your space in clean and good condition, all trash and personal belongings must be removed for your checkout inspection to be completed
- ✓ Make sure all furniture is moved back to its original place
- ✓ You can submit a [housing extension request form](#) from April 1-23

## Talk Derby to Me

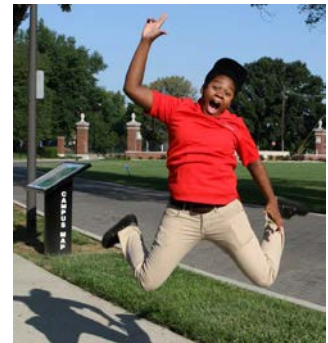
### *End of the year Derby Celebration*
