SCHEDULED MOVE-IN

LLC/TC EARLY ARRIVAL

EARLY ARRIVAL REQUESTS

If you have an extenuating circumstance, you may submit an "Early Arrival Request" under "Requests" in the Housing Portal. If approved, you will be able to schedule an early arrival appointment to move in as early as Monday, August 16th at 1:00 p.m.

DON'T FORGET



GETTING TO YOUR HALL (I-65 NORTH)



*I-65 North is accessible from I-265 and I-264.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Take I-65 North (toward Indianapolis) to Exit 133 at University Boulevard.
- 2. Turn left at the first traffic light onto University Boulevard.
- 3. Turn right at the next light (South Floyd Street) and travel toward the traffic circle.
- 4. Take the third exit of the traffic circle onto East Brandeis Avenue.
- 5. Continue onto East Cardinal Boulevard, and turn left at the fourth traffic light onto Fourth Street.
- 6. Continue through two lights, and turn left at the third traffic light into the Billy Minardi Parking lot, and follow the move-in signs.

GETTING TO YOUR HALL (I-65 SOUTH)



*I-65 South is accessible from I-71 and I-64.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Take I-65 South (toward Nashville) to Exit 135 at St. Catherine West.
- 2. Veer to the right when exiting I-65 onto St. Catherine West.
- 3. Make a left at the fourth traffic light onto Fourth Street.
- 4. Continue through seven traffic lights (the seventh being Cardinal Boulevard).
- 5. Continue on Fourth Street through two traffic lights.
- 6. Turn right at the third traffic light into the Billy Minardi parking lot, and follow the move-in signs.



UNLOADING

Each hall will follow a different traffic flow during move-in. View your hall's traffic map here. Residents who display the temporary parking pass below will be able to take advantage of free parking at their hall's unloading location during their one-hour APPOINTMENT ONLY. We encourage you to print your pass ahead of time; however, we will have extras available upon your arrival.

AFTER UNLOADING

Residents and families may take advantage of free parking in the yellow lot behind Bettie Johnson Hall (401 W. Cardinal Blvd.) following their appointment.

Be sure to stop by a Welcome Week tent around campus to pick up a Welcome Week schedule and campus map.

ROOM CONDITION REPORTS (RCR)

WIFI

Campus Housing provides free WiFi exclusive to our residence halls. All of our halls except for University Pointe and Cardinal Towne feature MyResNet WiFi. University Pointe and Cardinal Towne feature Pavlov Media. Get connected and start streaming from your personal devices at

LAUNDRY

All halls (excluding Cardinal Towne and University Pointe, which feature in-unit washer/dryer units) offer shared laundry facilities. Residents receive two free wash and two free dry cycles a week via the Speed Queen app*. Get started at

*Use the ULINK version of your UofL email (e.g. msblai09@louisville.edu) and select "Forgot Password" when creating an account so you can view your pre-loaded laundry stipend.

MEAL PLANS
