

FARLEY SCHOLARSHIP in COMPARATIVE HUMANITIES

The Department of Comparative Humanities is pleased to announce that it is now accepting applications for the Farley Scholarship in Humanities. This \$1,000 award is designed to recognize and encourage the study of the humanities amongst undergraduate Kentucky residents who are studying at the University of Louisville. The award will be applied to the winner(s)'s tuition costs through the Office of Financial Aid. More than one scholarship may be offered per year. The criteria for eligibility are:

- 1) Junior or Senior class standing,
- 2) Major in Humanities,
- 3) Kentucky residency,
- 4) An overall GPA of 3.00 (or higher),
- 5) Financial need (check with the Financial Aid Office if you are not sure of your eligibility), and
- 6) A one- to two-page essay (typed) on one of the two topics listed below.

If you meet all of the criteria, and would like to apply, please use the attached application form.

ESSAY TOPICS:

- 1) Explain what you think is the value of a Humanities or Liberal Arts major for today's society? You might want to write about what you have gained from your Humanities major so far or about what you expect to gain.
- 2) You and a friend whom you haven't seen since high school are having coffee; the conversation turns to college experiences, and your friend asks you what you are majoring in. When you say "Humanities," your friend looks puzzled and then asks, "What IS a Humanities major? And why did you choose Humanities?" In response, you say, . . .
