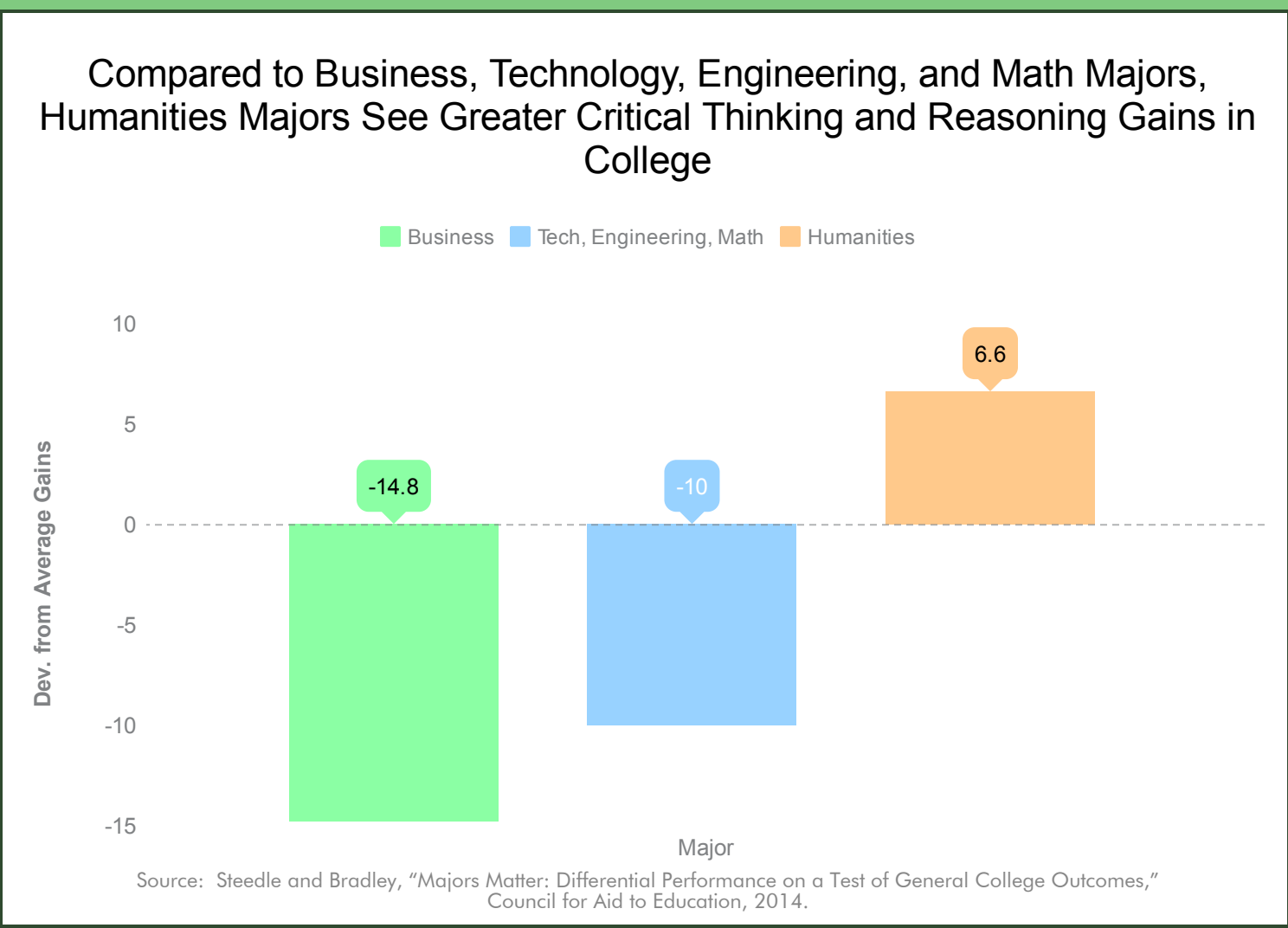
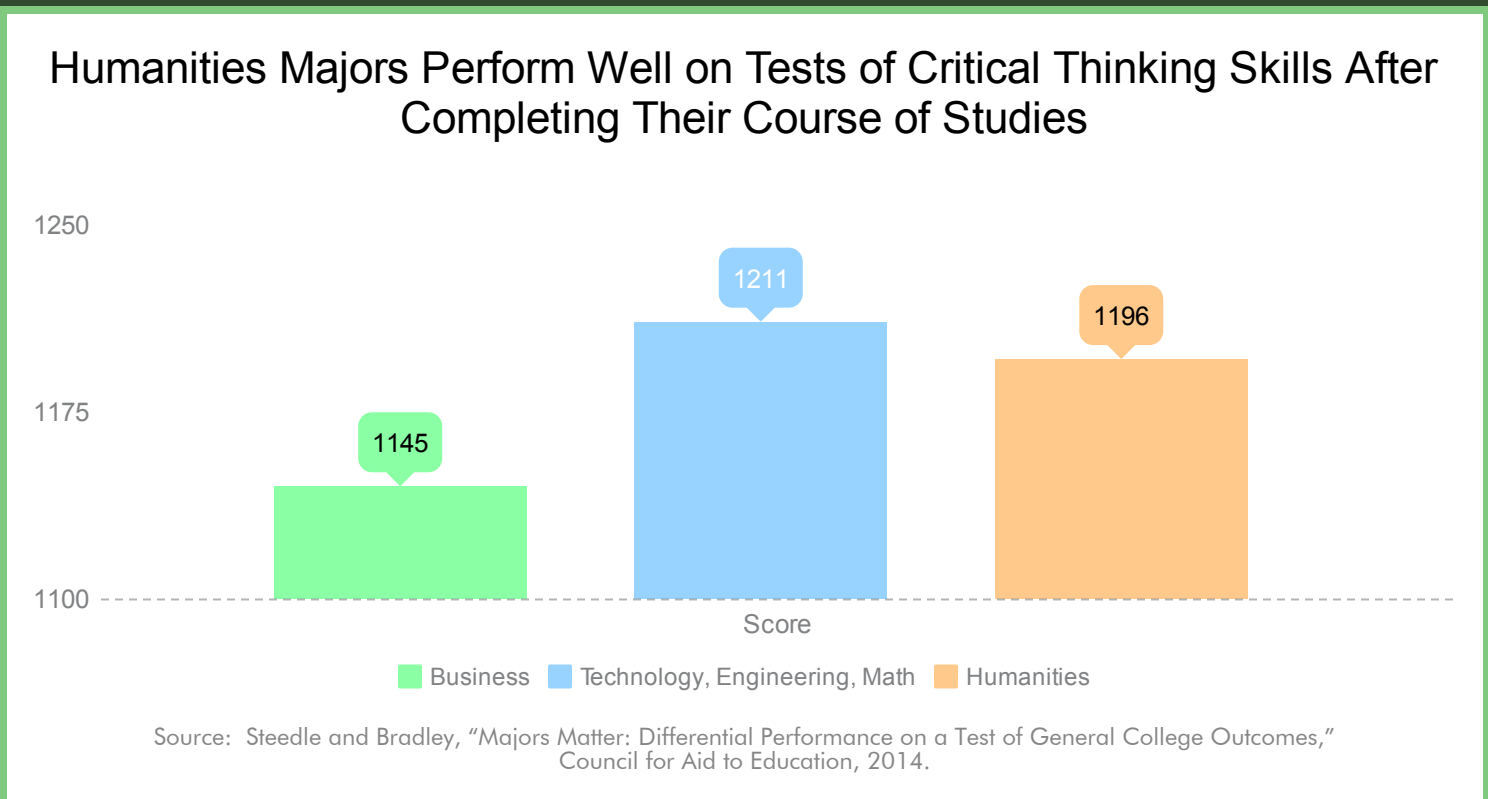


Humanities Majors Outperform Their Peers in Several Measures

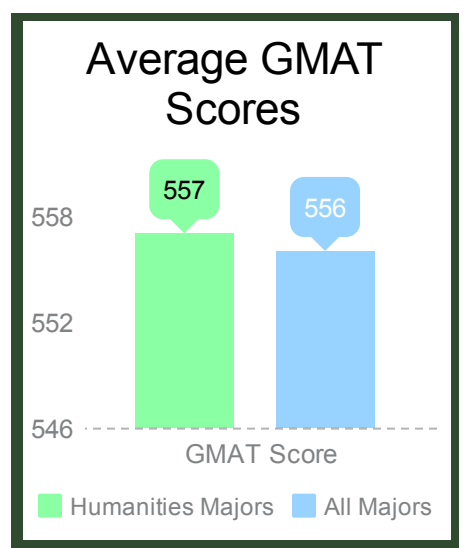
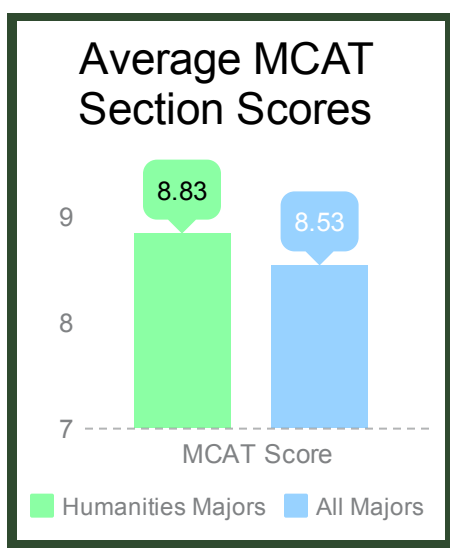
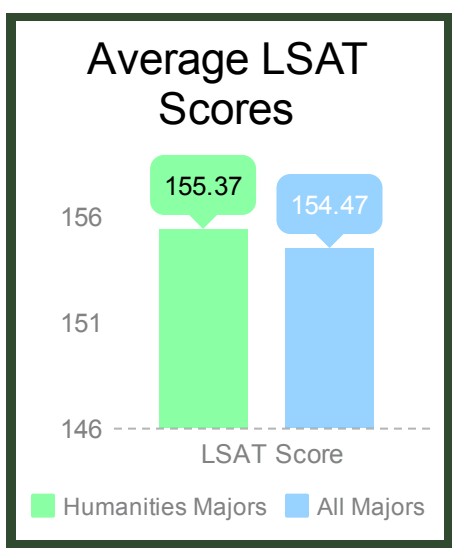

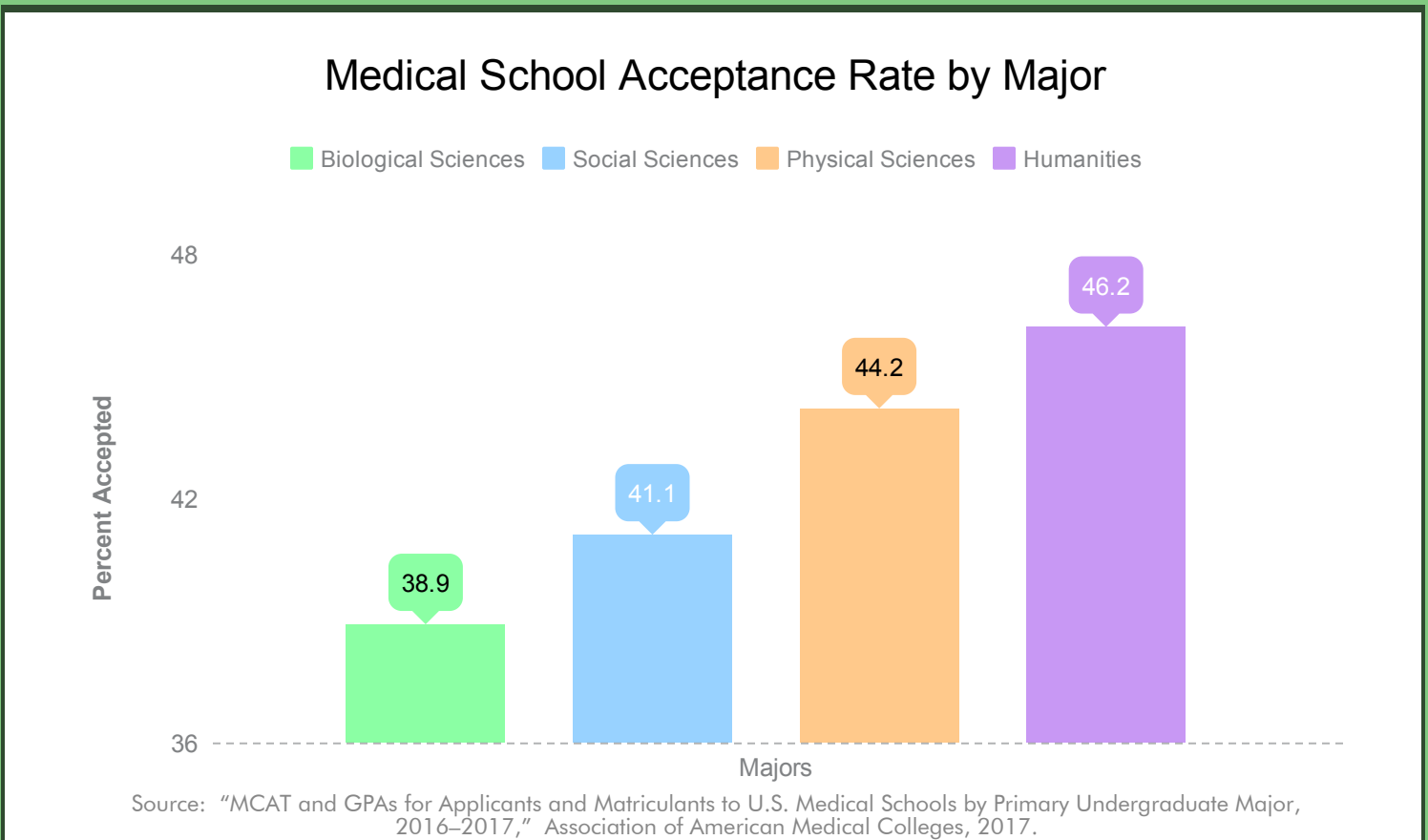
These above average gains in critical thinking ability among those who major in the humanities are accompanied by strong absolute scores on the Collegiate Learning Assessment.
