The following criteria shall be established and strictly adhered to:

1. Currently enrolled for a minimum of 6 credit hours;
2. Must have earned a minimum of 30 hours at the University of Louisville;
3. Must have maintained a 2.5 grade point average;
4. Provide a statement of justification for the award;
5. Complete the application attached and provide two (2) letters of recommendation, preferably from faculty at the University of Louisville;
6. Complete and submit this application on or before March 15th for award the following fall;
7. Preference may be given to students with unmet need who are not receiving other forms of financial aid;
8. Preference may be given to applicants who have a current FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) on file with the University's Financial Aid Office.
9. Scholarship recipients will be competitively selected based on their academic record and statement for justification of the award addressing these criteria.
