## 3 – Year Spring Start MSSW/MSCFT Dual Degree Curriculum Plan (84-hr)

The 3-year MSSW/MSCFT Degree program option allows a student to complete some of their foundational SW courses and continue to work before beginning their Couple and Family Therapy coursework. However, the course load becomes increased each year and in the second and particularly the third year, it would be very difficult to maintain anything more than part-time work.

If applying to the MSSW three-year plan, students may apply to the MSCFT degree simultaneously with the MSSW program or they may wait until December of their first year to apply to the MSCFT program (MSSW/CFT Dual degree).
