

3 – Year MSSW/MSCT Dual Degree Curriculum Plan (84 hr)

The 3-year MSSW/MSCT Degree program option allows a student to complete some of their foundational SW courses and continue to work before beginning their Couple and Family Therapy coursework. However, the course load becomes increased each year and in the second and particularly the third year, it would be very difficult to maintain anything more than part-time work.

Optional Courses – A Human Sexuality course is also required by some states, and students are encouraged to look at LMFT licensure requirements for states to which they may move to decide whether it is in their best interest to also take a Human Sexuality course.

Effective 2020-2021 The Advanced Research II course #669 is no longer required. The MSCT/MSSW Dual Degree curriculum plans have replaced 669 with 642 Psychopathology.

If applying to the MSSW three-year plan, students may apply to the MSCT degree simultaneously with the MSSW program or they may wait until December of their first year to apply to the MSCT program (MSSW/CFT Dual degree).
