

BSW Alcohol and Drug Counseling Track

Are you interested in the BSW Alcohol and Drug Counseling track while you are in the Upper Division? You will indicate this interest while applying to the Upper Division. This will allow you to start the course work in the fall semester of your junior year.

Upon acceptance to the ADC Track, students are required to complete the following four Social Work Upper Division Electives:

- 1. BSW 361: Special Issues Alcohol & Drug Counseling (mandatory)
- 2. BSW 362: Substance Use & Substance Use Disorders (mandatory)
- 3. BSW 460: Motivation and Change (mandatory)
- 4. BSW 415: Mental Health (mandatory)

<u>Practicum</u>: Students are required to complete their practicum in a substance abuse setting. This placement will be within a setting where a substantial portion of the focus is identification, intervention, or case management of clients who are alcohol and or drug dependent. Wherever possible, students in practicum settings will receive supervision by a CADC with two years' experience.
