



Ordering an APPT Language Assessment Online Registration Instructions

To register for your online assessment, please follow the directions below:

- Go to: www.languageesting.com to purchase your test and set up your account.
- On the left side of your screen, select the **language** in which you will be testing and click the **Get Certified** button:



- On the next screen, direct your attention to the right-hand column labeled **“I’m looking to test for teacher certification or as a part of my school program”** and choose the following option:




