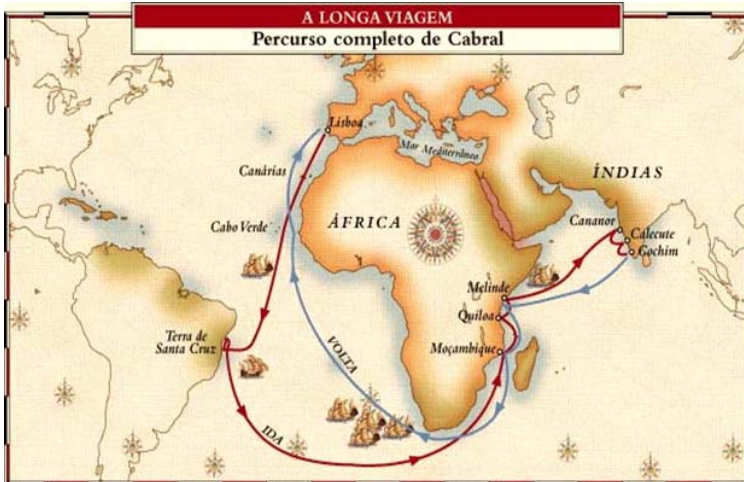


LALS 321-50: Luso-Brazilian Cross

This online course provides an understanding and critical examination of Luso-Brazilian culture. Throughout the course we will make connections between Portuguese and Afro influences and identity to formulate interpretations of modern Brazilian culture and society.

This course explores the Luso-Brazilian cross cultural connections through its language and arts (music, film, literature, painting, and dance). Discussion topics include: Brazil's geography, cultural similarities and differences between Brazil and rest of the Portuguese-speaking world, regional characteristics and differences within Brazil, major historical events, Brazilian folklore and festivities, life in modern-day Brazil, and Brazilian values.
