- 3. Two recommendations: Please advise the two professors who recommend you that they should submit their recommendation form in an email directly to **Dr. Medina by Wednesday, February 1, 2023.**
- 4. As Lewis Scholars, students are expected to fulfill the grant's requirements and serve as peer mentors to other students to encourage interest in Latin American and Iberian area studies.
- 5. Lewis Scholars are required to submit a written report detailing their experience and include a photo (or several) from their trip within 30 days after returning to Louisville. This report should be submitted to Dr. Manuel Medina, LALS Program Director, and addressed to Mrs. Constance Lewis.

Decisions will be made before the end of January 2023, and students will be notified via email. Recipients are expected to return the letter of intent, which indicates that they accept the terms of this scholarship, by Monday, February 30, 2023. **Please notify Dr. Medina immediately if your plans to study abroad change.**
