1ST ANNUAL ESSAY CONTEST & SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

KAAA is a non-profit professional association comprised of hearing officers, administrative law judges, and administrative law practitioners in private practice and government service.

ESSAY TOPIC:

Explain the importance of due process in administrative law.

CONTEST GUIDELINES:

WHO MAY APPY: Any law student who is actively attending and in good standing with an accredited law school.

REQUIREMENTS: Maximum 1000 words. Original work. Typed. 12-point font. Double spaced. Numbered pages. White paper. Include name, law school, address, phone number, and email in the header of each page of essay. Essays will be judged on creativity.

EXTENDED DEADLINE: **APRIL 15, 2019**. Submissions must be postmarked by deadline and mailed to the address above or emailed to <u>Katie.gabhart@ky.gov</u> with the subject line "KAAA Essay Contest."

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD: \$1,000 (funds will be provided in a check directly to recipient)

Award will be given to the winning recipient at the KAAA Annual Conference on **Friday, May 10, 2019, 1:00 pm**, at the Administrative Office of the Courts, 1001 Vandalay Drive, Frankfort, Kentucky. RECIPIENT MUST BE PRESENT TO ACCEPT THE AWARD. The winning recipient will be notified by May 1, 2019.
