ELECTION PROTECTION: Election Protection (EP) – led by the Lawyers' Committee for Civil Rights Under Law - is the nation's largest **non-partisan** voter protection coalition. Election Protection's national voter hotlines (866-OUR-VOTE, 888-VE-Y-VOTA & 888-API-VOTE)¹ and Election Day field programs assist voters with problems and guide them throughout the voting process, regardless of their party affiliation. EP also provides critical legal resources year round, including for early voting, voter registration, election officials, and grassroots organizations. Election Protection is a resource for all Americans.
