1. Get a commitment
  - a. What do you think is going on?
  - b. What other info do you feel are needed
  - c. What would you like to accomplish in this visit
  
2. Probe for supporting evidence
  - a. Why do you think this?
  - b. What were the major findings that led to your conclusion?
  - c. What else do you consider?
  
3. Teach general rules
  
4. Reinforce what was right
  - a. Tell them what they did right and the effect it had
  - b. Identify specific behaviors—why right
  
5. Correct mistakes
  - a. Tell them what they did not do right
  - b. Identify specific behaviors
  - c. Tell them how to improve for next time
