# Symposium Overview

This adult developmental medicine and dentistry course (a first-time initiative at UofL) will present a multidisciplinary approach needed for the care and treatment of adult patients with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) in order to educate and inform health care providers, patients and their caregivers about best current practices and future treatment directions for patients with IDD. Several disciplines will be represented including psychiatry, genetics, physical medicine and rehab and dentistry. It is also expected that this cross-sectional platform. which will include panel discussions and a family case presentation luncheon, will stimulate insightful physician/dentist and patient discussions in a collaborative environment and improve the regional standard of care.

# Target Audience

The target audience for this seminar is dentistry, neurology, psychiatry, psychology, family medicine, internal medicine, pediatrics, social work, nursing and other healthcare providers with an interest in IDD.

# **Learning Objectives**

- Identify the cross-cultural dynamic that has contributed to disparities in oral and systemic healthcare for Americans with IDD and focus on strategies for improving access to quality healthcare for these individuals.
- > Discuss the Five Essential Concepts of Developmental Medicine and Dentistry as a critical thinking construct, which can shape an organized approach to the diagnosis and clinical management of the medical and dental patient with IDD.
- > Recognize the importance of assembling an interdisciplinary team when approaching the patient with IDD, and identify the key members of that team.
