#### Common Terms

- Intellectual Disability (1 in 44)
- Autism (1 in 68)
- Cerebral Palsy (1 in 323)
- Down syndrome (1 in 691)
- Fetal alcohol spectrum disorder (1 in 3000)
- Fragile X syndrome (1 in 4000)
- Neurodevelopmental Disorders



# Medically Underserved Population

- The federal government may designate different populations as a "MUP".
- AMA resolution 805-i-10 supports this
- ADA resolution 96H-2014 supports this
- Yet the federal government fails to recognize this population as such.



#### **Unmet Health Needs**

- Special Olympics Data (average age: 24)
  - Active Dental Pain 17%
  - Low Bone Density 20%
  - Hearing Loss 23%
  - Vision Impairment 27%
  - Obesity/Overweight 70+%



# Prescription Patterns

- 25% more likely to get a prescription
- 300% more likely to continue a prescription
- 46% of psychotropic drugs don't have a corresponding psychiatric diagnosis
- 13% of anti-seizure drugs don't have a corresponding seizure diagnosis



# Systemic Problems

- Untrained doctors
- Aging population
- Deinstitutionalization, the social model and unprepared community health infrastructure
- Fragmented healthcare system
- Payment systems
- Culture of low expectations



#### Classic Scenario

- Behavioral complaint
- Doc prescribes behavioral drugs
- Underlying physical problem is ignored
- Behaviors slightly improve
- Physical problem gets worse
- Physical problem is eventually addressed (usually in a more advanced state)
- Behavior drugs continue
- No focus on prevention



# Parting Wisdom

- Willingness and confidence
- Accurate information
- Prevention, communication, interdisciplinary thinking
- Do not make assumptions
  - Question previous diagnoses
  - Question previous treatments
  - Do not assume that behaviors have a psychiatric basis (look for sources of pain)
- Treat the patient like a person
