Our program is housed in the Department of Family and Geriatric Medicine and is closely affiliated with the University of Louisville Center on Aging. We are accredited by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education for this one year post-graduate education program for physicians who have completed a residency in Family Medicine or Internal Medicine.
