#### OUR ENDOWMENT FUNDS

We have five endowment funds which support our mission to educate students and residents .

- 1. The **Dermatology and Dermatopathology Endowment Fund** This fund was originated by Dr. LG Owen for the purpose of support for Faculty and/or Fellows. The contributed funds predominated from Dr. Owen and his colleagues in Dermatopathology over the years including Drs. Fabre, Malone, Bahrami, Hood and Farmer, but all faculty who staff clinics without pay have helped to raise funds for this endowment.
- 2. The **Bernice Fine Memorial Lectureship in Cutaneous Medicine** This fund began when Lew Fine, MD left money in his will to support a yearly lectureship.
- 3. The **Jeffrey P. Callen, MD Lectureship fund** We now have pledges of \$269,025.00 and have collected \$262,775.00.
- 4. **Dermatology Resident Education Fund—**We will face limited resources in the future and wish to develop a fund the support the costs associated with resident travel and education. This fund has cash and pledges of \$156,167.19 at present, but our goal is \$400,000.00.
- 5. **Drs. James and Vickie Turner Dermatology Lectureship Fund** this is a new fund that is fully funded through a generous gift from the Drs. Turner.
- **6. LG Owen Professorship fund**—in Dr. Owen's will he has indicated a substantial gift to start a Named Professorship in Dermatology at UofL. We would like to have additions in order to reach a goal of this fund being for a Named Chair.

## CHALLENGING CASE FOR DIAGNOSIS— ANSWER FROM THE SPRING 2019 NEWSLETTER

This 54-year-old woman with a history of discoid lupus erythematosus developed the pictured changes on the posterior thighs within the past month. She was asymptomatic.

What is the best diagnosis?

- 1. Cutaneous polyarteritis
- 2. Erythema ab igne
- 3. Anti-phospholipid antibody syndrome
- 4. Cryoglobulinemia
- 5. Topical steroid overuse



**Discussion** The patient admitted to regular use of her car seat warmer. Subsequently, she has had some resolution of the process with residual dyspigmentation.

# CHALLENGING CASE (ANSWER IN THE SPRING 2020 NEWSLETTER)

A 41-year-old woman with a history of multiple sclerosis, psoriasis and psoriatic arthritis on oral fingolimod 0.5 mg/d, oral methotrexate 15 mg/w, and monthly IV abatacept presented with a 7-month history of widespread skin lesions.

What should be done for management of these lesions?

- 1. Stop abatacept
- 2. Stop methotrexate
- 3. Stop fingolimod
- 4. Treat with liquid nitrogen
- 5. Treat with topical imiquimod
