**OUR ENDOWMENT FUNDS**

We have five endowment funds which support our mission to educate students and residents .

1. The **Dermatology and Dermatopathology Endowment Fund** - This fund was created by Dr. LG Owen for the purpose of support for Faculty and/or Fellows. The contributed funds predominated from Dr. Owen and his colleagues in Dermatopathology over the years including Drs. Fabre, Malone, Bahrami, Hood and Farmer, but all faculty who staff clinics without pay have helped to raise funds for this endowment.
2. The **Bernice Fine Memorial Lectureship in Cutaneous Medicine** - This fund began when Lew Fine, MD left money in his will to support a yearly lectureship. In the 2019-2020 academic year Dr. Keith Choate of Yale University was the Fine Lecturer, and in the current academic year, Dr. John McGrath, of King's College in London was our lecturer.
3. The **Jeffrey P. Callen, MD Lectureship fund** - This fund was created by Susan Callen to commemorate Dr. Callen's 25 years as Chief of the Division. We have raised over \$300,000.00 for this fund and have supported multiple visiting professors since its inception.
4. **Dermatology Resident Education Fund**—We will face limited resources in the future and wish to develop a fund to support the costs associated with resident travel to academic meetings as well as purchase of books and equipment for use in clinical practice. This fund is now over halfway to our goal of \$400,000.00.
5. **Drs. James and Vickie Turner Dermatology Lectureship Fund**— this fund was created to support a Named Lecturer annually by a gift from James and Vickie Turner. This academic year we will be hosting Ted Rosen as the Turner Lecturer.
6. **LG Owen Professorship fund**— Dr. LG Owen's will designated 2 million dollars to support faculty salary. Funds from his estate have now arrived and were enhanced by a substantial addition by Dr. M. Tye Haeberle. Our goal is for this fund to eventually provide support for a full-time professor at UofL, but in order to do that, we need to raise another 2 million dollars.
