## WHO WE ARE:

The University of Louisville Division of Infectious Diseases houses the Civil Surgeon Program which helps refugees, immigrants, and their families take the first steps in applying for their green card.

## WHAT WE PROVIDE:

- Completion of I-693 or other government form
  - Physical Examination
  - Vaccines
  - Testing for Tuberculosis and other requested conditions
- 

## COST:

The cost for a Civil Surgeon examination will vary from person to person. However, our program offers competitive pricing and provides the examination, vaccines, laboratory tests and the documentation all on-site in the clinic.

---

## REMEMBER:

- You must be in the United States for at least 12 months to apply for a green card.
- Make an appointment once you have been here for 11 months.
- After you contact us we will ensure you have the documentation needed to complete this process.

## WHAT TO BRING TO YOUR APPOINTMENT:

- A mask to wear during the visit
- Photo identification (passport, driver's license)
- I-94 card (refugees, parolees, asylees)
- Immunization records
- Interpreter for non-English and non-Spanish speakers
- Refugees can arrange an interpreter through a resettlement agency or we can provide an interpreter for an additional charge of \$2/minute during the visit
