Testing new approaches to treat babies born in opioid withdrawal

As the opioid epidemic continues to affect families across the United States, opioid exposure in the uterus has attracted attention as a serious problem affecting babies in every corner of America. When a woman uses opioids while she is pregnant, her newborn baby can be difficult to console, have an unusually high-pitched cry, and be unable to eat and sleep well. In infants, these are all symptoms of opioid withdrawal. According to the most recently available data, in the United States a baby is born every 15 minutes suffering from opioid withdrawal.

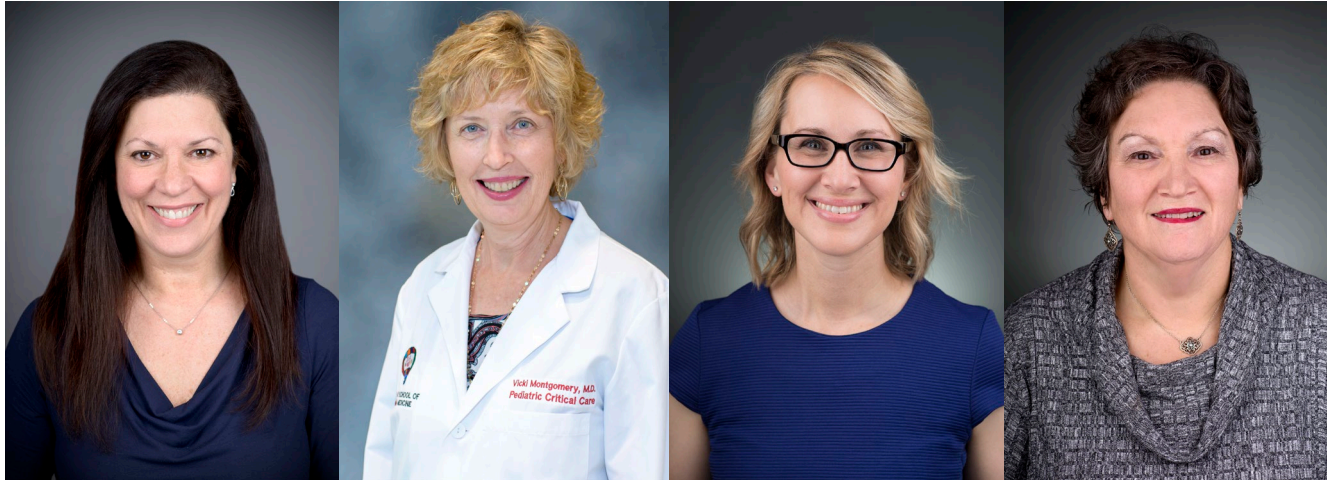
Neonatal Opioid Withdrawal Syndrome, or NOWS, is a particularly heartbreaking part of the opioid epidemic. The Advancing Clinical Trials in Neonatal Opioid Withdrawal (ACT NOW) study funded by the Helping to End Addiction Long-term™ Initiative, or NIH HEAL Initiative™ is working on solutions.

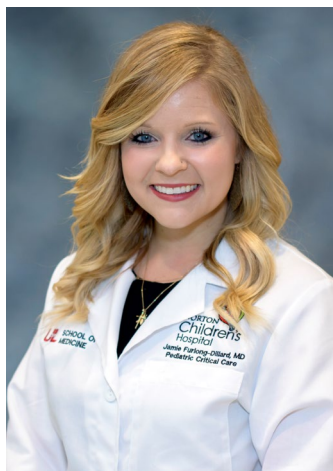

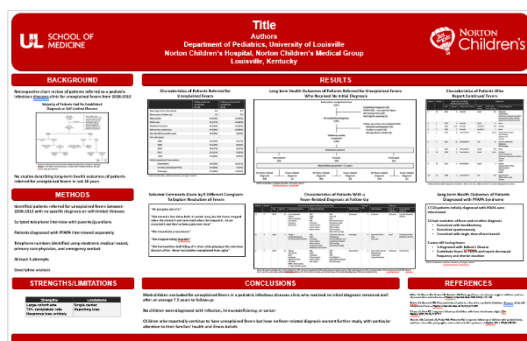
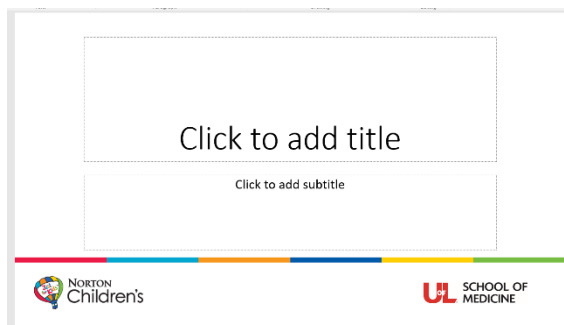
