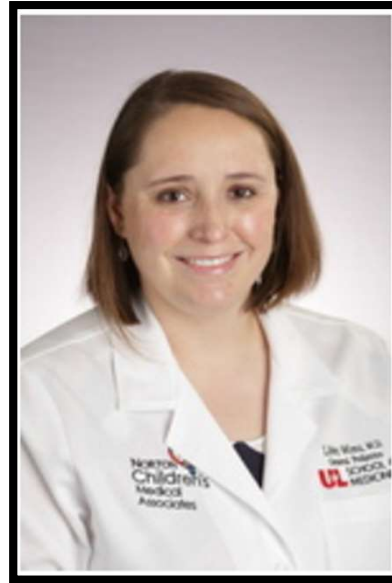

UofL Employees (faculty, staff, fellows) are often confused what Family Medical Leave (FML) is and how it is used...

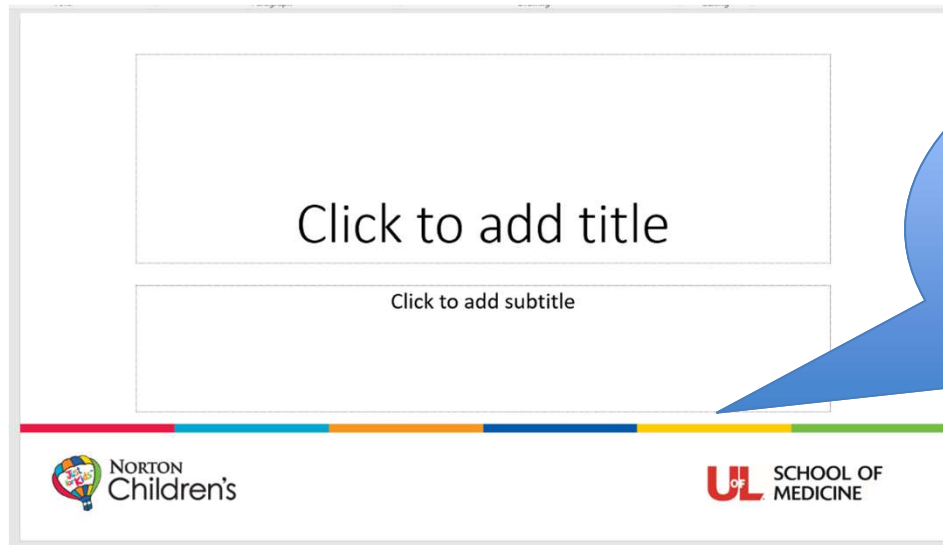
