

- ► Shaped the delivery of neonatal care within the Commonwealth by establishing Neonatal Intensive Care Units in Paducah, Owensboro and Elizabethtown, where no local neonatal services were previously available
- ► Recognized national leader in neonatal resuscitation, as well as in the use of inhaled nitric oxide for pulmonary hypertension
- ▶ Involved in national trials for surfactant replacement in the neonate and a champion for Extracorporeal Life Support
- ► Authored nearly 100 articles in peer reviewed journals.
- ► Served two terms on the American Academy of Medicine policy setting body, the Committee on Fetus and Newborn
- ▶ In addition to advocacy at the local, state, and national venues, has also enhanced the capability of Romanian physicians to provide neonatal care and assistance to improve healthcare in many countries including Italy, Spain, Poland, Moldova, Kuwait, Qatar, Abu Dhabi, Vietnam, Ghana, South Africa and Ecuador
