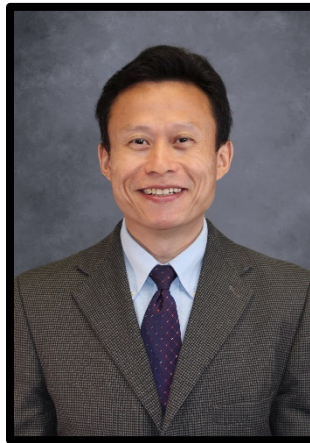

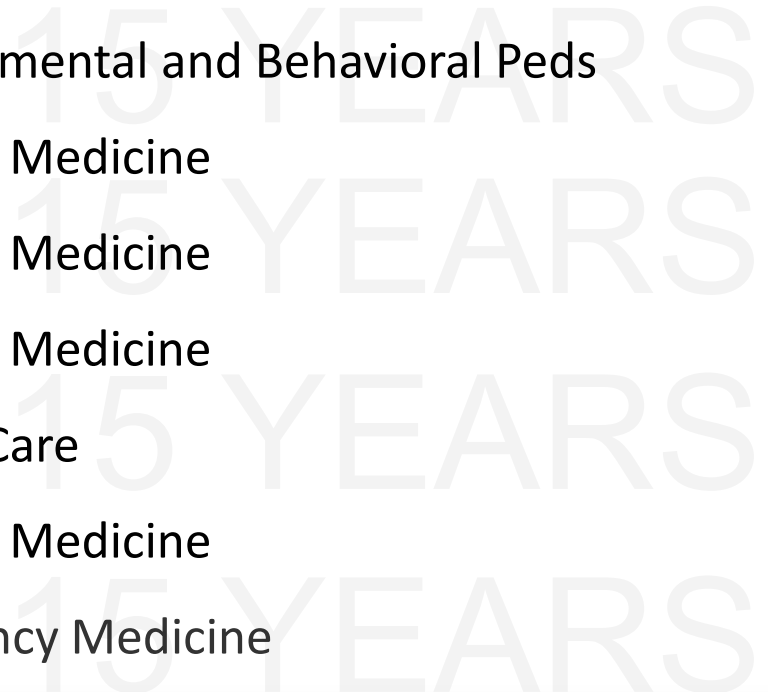

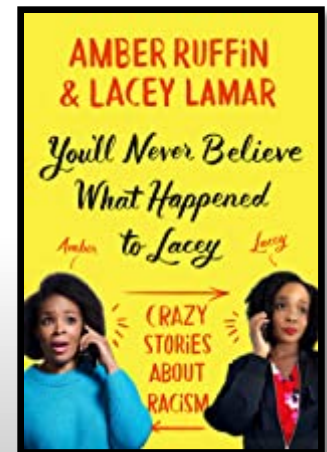
Peds Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion *2022 Book Club*

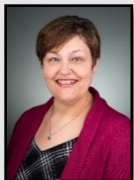
