




2020 Successes

Mislabeled Specimens per Year








UPDATES

- MOC4 credit available for participation in Reaching for Zero Committee activities. If you want to join the committee, just let me know.
- Guidelines MOC4 credit available for leading or participating in Guideline development and implementation
- Surgical Site Infection Colon
- Nephrotoxic medication associated acute kidney injury
 - 1 child about every 2.5 days with an exposure event
 - Since January 2019 in general medical-surgical patients 12 kids who developed AKI (patients who had creatinine measured)
- Unplanned extubation, especially in the NICU
 - 130 in 2016 vs 43 in 2020
 - 81 babies since 2017 who did not have a significant destabilizing event; 74 CICU/PICU patients
 - Since 2017 didn't spend over \$14,000,000
