Excellence in Teaching: Requirements

- Documented substantial teaching assignment
 - Major responsibility/ leadership role
- Descriptions of the frequency and duration of the responsibility, outcomes, and evaluations of the outcomes
- Peer and supervisory reviews = excellent teaching performance
- Reviews by learners = excellent teaching effectiveness.

Examples of Excellence in Teaching:

- Teaching awards
- Engaging in structured mentoring or advising activities
- Developing new instructional or curricular materials
- Evidence of learning and critical thinking skills
- Participation in interdisciplinary teaching efforts
